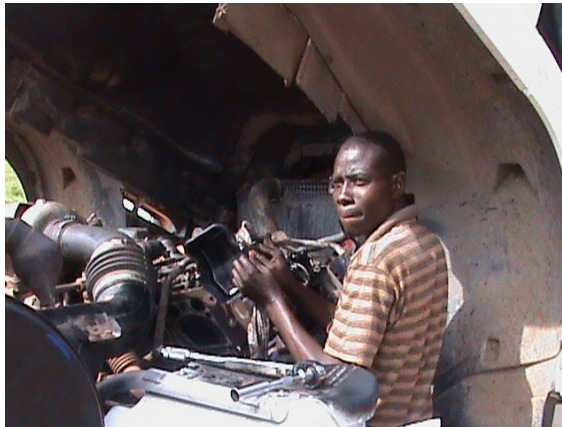


## C.E.O.'s introduction,

In order to give a clear idea of what the IGP is accomplishing here I will run through a few of their current projects. The Income Generating Project currently employs 10 individuals from the surrounding communities. This in turn provides steady income to 10 families. The IGP also works hand in hand with Bringing Hope to the Family, Embrace Uganda and Global Support Mission.

Embrace Uganda (EU) and Global Support Mission (GSM) have both raised funds for numerous needs to assist Bringing Hope to the Family. But, several of these items have

needed to be constructed. The IGP has stepped up and provided their services in order to complete the projects. It is encouraging to see the body of Christ working together.

Projects that the IGP has been able to work in conjunction with EU and GSM are: a playground for Home Again orphanage, hand washing stations for Hope Again Medical Centre, doors and windows for Home Again's new kitchen/dining area and wiring Home Again's lower house for electricity. The IGP has also provided a lot of service to GSM's volunteer house. They have assisted from gutters, to window screens, to cabinets, to constructing a tank stand.



About 2 months ago a teenage boy from Home Again was riding his bicycle in Kaihura when he was struck by a passing vehicle. He was in very bad shape. Phillip Grigg and a few others attended to him. Here in rural Uganda there are only a few ambulances which consist of a Land Cruiser and a stretcher. Even these are hard to get when in need. Phil and the others with him had to carry Robert as best they could. They transported Robert in Phil's Hilux

to the nearest hospital which is about 45 minutes away.

After an emergency operation Robert was transported to Kampala to be treated at a major hospital. The hospital in Kampala is still far from the standards that we would be accustomed to. The hospitals here do not have stretchers, so the patients have to be carried room to room by the people who brought them. Their day to day care has to be provided by their loved ones as well since hospitals cannot afford the necessary staff. Basic medicines often have to be provided from outside the hospital also.
